- Many teachers will "distribute" and "collect" assignments via Google Classroom. Please refer to your teacher's communication for details. The students are familiar with Google classroom.
- Students must sign into their **Millstone Google Account** to have access to daily assignments.
- At this time, the most efficient way to communicate with the school will be through email.

Acceptable Use of Technology

Any student seeking to use the technological resources of Millstone Township School District must sign an Acceptable Use of Technology form to ensure that he or she will not attempt to acquire data for purposes not related to the educational goals of the District. This form must be signed by the student and student's parent or guardian using the facilities. These terms and conditions supersede all prior oral or written agreements and understandings. Any student and parent or guardian who does not submit a signed Acceptable Use of Technology form will not have access to the computers or related technologies available in the schools. The following is in direct alignment with **Policy 2361: Acceptable Use of Computer Network/Computers and Resources** and **Policy 2360: Use of Technology**. All users are prohibited from the following actions:

- Using the district system to engage in illegal activities.
- Disrupting, vandalizing or gaining unauthorized access to equipment, software, files or the operation of any system and/or violating copyrights or otherwise using the intellectual property of another individual or organization without permission or citation.
- Obtaining or creating pornographic text, graphics, or photographs.
- Using abusive or obscene language to send hate mail, harass another individual, violate the law or school policy.
- Using technology for personal, financial, or business gain.
- Logging onto the network or sending e-mail using another's identity.
- Developing bulletin boards, chat groups, or e-mail broadcasting.
- Altering the configuration of any Chromebook.
- Disabling or otherwise modifying any technology protection or measures on school issued devices.
- Accessing messaging services or social media sites.

Students are given digital storage space to save their school related work. This storage space belongs to the Millstone Township School District and is not guaranteed to be private. Using the space to store non-school related files is a violation of the Acceptable Use of Technology agreement. Messages related to, or in support of, illegal activities may be reported to the authorities. In the event that there is a violation, the consequences will follow the existing student conduct code. If a student uses the Internet, computer, email, or any other means to copy another user's material, the student will be disciplined. It is important that each user safeguard his or her work.
